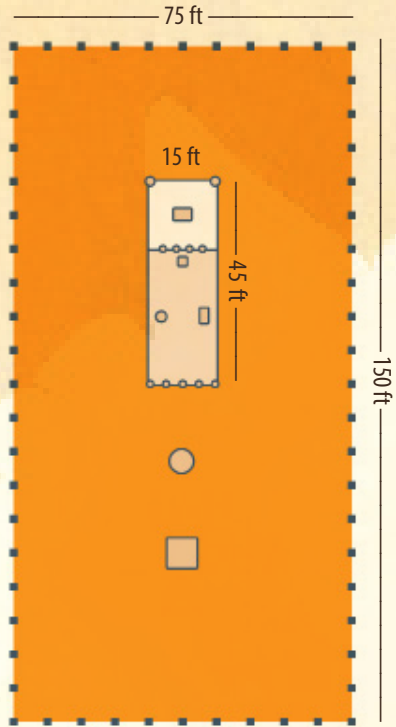
# TABERNACLE & ARK OF THE COVENANT

PTP will feature a full-sized replica of the Tabernacle from the Old Testament.

We will measure out the exact size of the tabernacle with pipe and drape. Along with this visual layout of the original Tabernacle, there will be full-sized replicas of all of the furniture, including the Ark of the Covenant and the Alter of Burnt Offering. Students will be able to tour the replica and get a taste of what it was like to be among God's people during the time of Moses.

The Tabernacle will feature historical and interactive exhibits, and provides a unique learning opportunity for all.

We did and invited a speaker to discuss sermon preparation and give sample sermons. Interest increased; more speakers were invited. We moved to a hotel conference area. We dreamed big. "Let's invite the best speakers in the brotherhood and see who we can get." They came. Wives wanted in, so we added women's classes. While these great speakers were assembled in one place, we decided to offer classes for elders. They loved it. People began coming from all over the country.

Youth workers and deacons became interested. We added tracks for them. PTP moved to a large event center in the Smoky Mountains. Attendance approached 1000. Christians from other nations began coming.

"Why don't you have classes for regular members?" we were asked. So we added Spiritual Renewal Weekend, as well as tracks for members, teens, and children. Attendance surpassed 2000.

That brings us to 2012. The largest PTP ever is in the works—126 speakers, 12 concurrent sessions each hour, 601 separate classes spread over seven days. Our attendance goal is 2500.

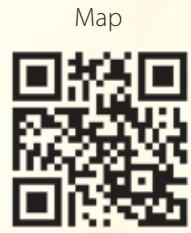
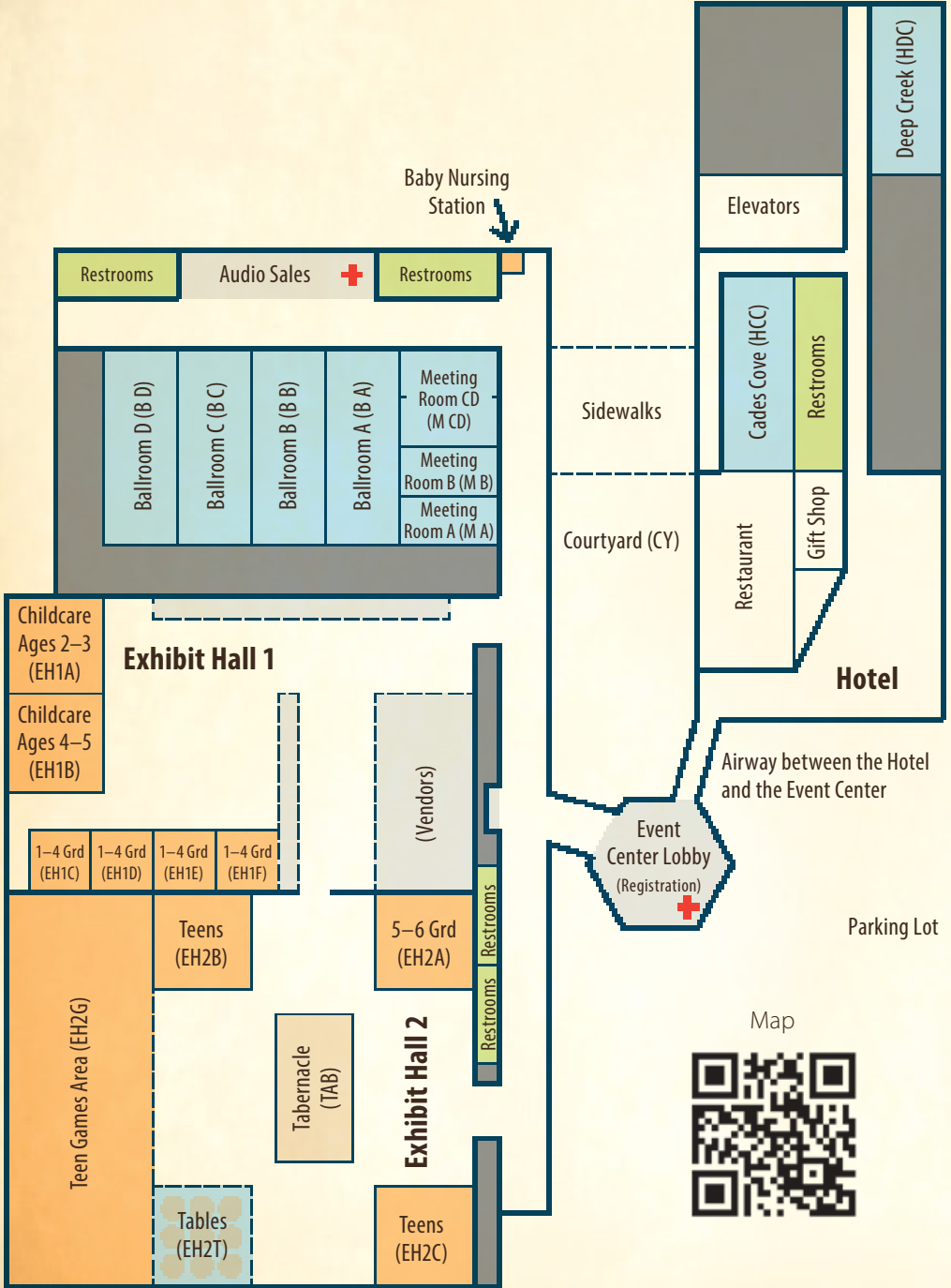


# EVENT CENTER MAP

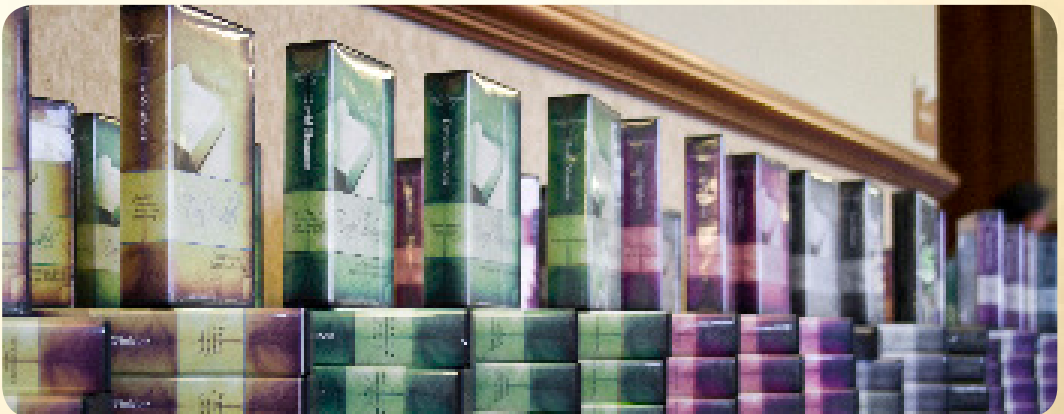

## Ages 2–5

We offer childcare for potty-trained children five and under. The charge is only \$50 no matter how many children you have in this group, or how many days you stay. 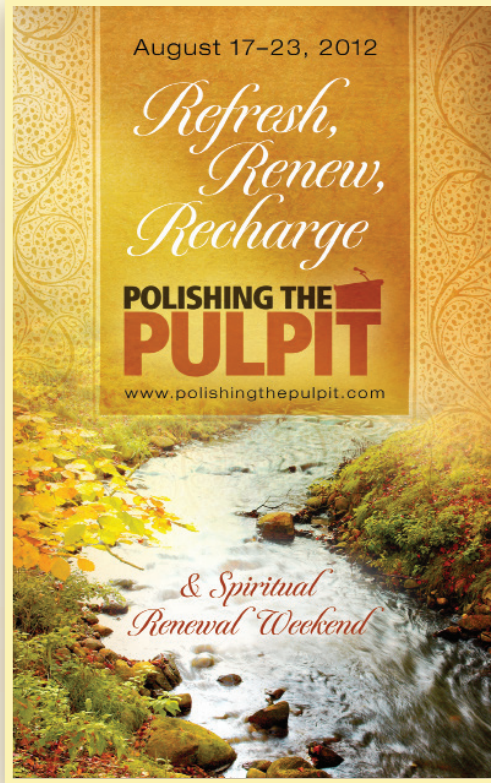
