### **HIGHLIGHTS THIS YEAR**

**Keynote Series: Jesus' Ten Greatest Questions.** As the Master Teacher, Jesus asked penetrating, timeless questions. Join us in Branson, Missouri, as we examine what may be the ten most important questions ever asked.



### CERTIFICATE PROGRAM



Receive a PTP certificate by attending PTP classes! Successful participation for five years (32 hours of instruction per year) in the certificate program qualifies for the PTP diploma. There is no additional charge.

Pick up a certificate form at the information desk or PTP check-in.

### THE PROCESS:

**Step 1:** Choose your track.

**Step 2:** Sign up for the program at the PTP registration table.

**Step 3:** Attend 20 classes from a single track and 12 elective classes and record them on the certificate form.


**Step 4:** At the end of PTP, return your form and signed honor code with the list of classes you attended and a statement that your notes are assembled in proper order. (You do not turn in your notebook.)

**Step 5:** Turn in your certificate form at the information desk or mail it in after the event when you complete five years of instruction. Your certificate will be signed and mailed to you after PTP.

### **FAQs**

"Is registration required if I am only coming for one day?" Yes, everyone must register. You can do this when you arrive.

"Is applause appropriate after speeches?" No, but amens are encouraged!

"What is the usual dress for ses**sions?"** Dress as you would for Sunday morning church. Many men wear sports coats, dress shirts, or pullover collared shirts. Ladies wear dresses or dress pants. Suits and dresses are usual for worship services. The directors request conservative modesty rules be observed throughout: no shorts, no skirts above the knee, no tight clothing, no tops that show cleavage. These rules apply to both males and females, and include teens/pre-teens attending any event (even offsite). Those not dressed appropriately will be asked to change. The dress code is for those of school age through adults. (These rules do not apply to those five years old and younger.)

"May I record the sessions?" Yes, from your seat. You may not put anything on the stage, and no cords are allowed in the aisles. You may not live stream or post on social media or the internet.

"May ladies attend men's sessions?"
Yes.

"May men attend ladies' sessions?" No (1 Timothy 2:12–13).

"Must I stay in one track?" No, you can attend the classes that interest you most.

"What about the hotel pools?" The pool is not available for PTPers. The directors and overseeing elders oppose mixed swimming because of the Bible's teaching on modesty (1 Timothy 2:9), our responsibility to avoid being a stumbling block to others (Romans 14:13), and our need to avoid putting ourselves into the path of temptation (Matthew 5:28; 6:13).

"It's too cold in the classrooms." It is hard to maintain a constant temperature in a big facility. The result is that it gets either too cold or too hot. Too cold is

preferable, given our dress code. You may want to bring a sweater or jacket.

**"Parking?"** The uncovered lot next to the convention center will be free during PTP. The parking garage charges \$15 per day. Other options are The Landing across the street, and free parking in the Bass Pro Shops lot across from the convention center. Any private lots that allow parking during events will post their own rates.

"The classrooms are too small. I couldn't get in one session I really wanted." We try to put the most popular subjects and speakers in larger venues, but just about everybody on the program is an outstanding presenter, so we run out of large rooms. If there is someone you really want to hear in a smaller classroom, we suggest you get there early. Remember, anything that you miss, Lord willing, will be accessible after PTP so you can hear it later. Plus, there are other awesome sessions going on in larger rooms at the same time. Roll with it and hear somebody new (who may become a new favorite).

"Will child care and children's classes be available?" Yes, for ages 2 (must be potty-trained) and up. There is no charge.

"May I take my child under 2 into sessions?" Yes. We ask that parents take a child out immediately if he/she cries or makes noise. You will be able to listen to the lesson after PTP.

"There is a screaming child in my class, and I can't hear what's going

on." Parenting is a struggle. We've all been there. PTP has done what we can to help this situation. We have free classes at most times for 2-year-olds and up. We have signs asking mothers to take a crying child out immediately. Remind yourself that you are a selfless Christian and that you know parents want to hear, too. It can be tiring and frustrating to be left out of sessions you really wanted to attend. The good news is that there are digital downloads available, so everyone gets to hear the lesson later. There's a play area for the younger children. Be thankful they are rearing their children in the Lord. They are the future of the church.

"Can my child move up a class because his/her birthday is coming up soon?" We have struggled with this. There are logistical problems when you are working with 900 children. What we do is give parents the option to send a child to either class in the transition year. The transition years are ages 6 and 11. 6-year-olds transition to PTP VBS. That is, if your child is turning 6 anytime this year, he may go to the 5- or 6-year-old class. 11-year-olds transition to PTP Camp. That is, if you child is turning 11 anytime this year, she may go to the 10-year-old class or PTP camp. However, they must go to the class you signed up for when registering them. We hear all kinds of reasons why a child should move up or down. We cannot make exceptions to keep siblings together or because a child is smart and "belongs" in a higher class. Please respect

"Can my 12-year-old go to teen classes and events?" Only children who will be teenagers in the calendar year 2025 may attend events.

the benefit and safety of all the children.


**"Is Internet access available?"**The BCC offers free convention center WiFi for guests.

## Classes teens actually want to go to!

Hear rock-solid truth presented by great speakers who understand young people.

### Singing straight from heaven

Sing old favorites, learn new favorites, and praise God with the voice He gave you. End every night with the Atrium singing.

### **Night owls**

Late Night activities include games and off-site activities. It's all about building meaningful relationships. Teens love the classes, but they buzz about the fellowship. It's about people—seeing old friends and meeting new ones. Some friendships begin at PTP and last a lifetime—even into heaven! Important stuff:

- Appropriate dress for sessions is pants and shirts. No shorts, skirts above the knee, or low necklines anytime at PTP (including social events and after hours). Seriously. PTP T-shirts are highly thought of!
- The directors ask that we not use the pool areas at any time during PTP (see FAQs).
- Maps/directions available in the PTP Branson 2025 app.

Note to Parents: This is one of the largest segments of PTP! Teens have different activity options throughout the week. We do not provide transportation to off-site locations. Teens are free to leave Late Night activities early if parents prefer them back for an earlier bedtime. It is the responsibility of parents to ensure that their teen is in the right place and gets back to the hotel safely. We will have chaperones on site for teen events, and parents must accompany pre-teens.

### Mike Bliss—Comedy and Magic Show

All pre-teens and teens are invited to this exciting, fun, on-site show. Laughs, tricks, and some pick-pocketing, all wrapped up in one memorable show. Preteens (Age 10–12) must have adult supervision. Teen parents may attend. Cost: free.

### **Coral Reef Mini Golf**

Enjoy mini golf, ping pong, foosball, shuffleboard, and other games. Outside food is allowed, but outside drinks are not allowed. Water is \$2; Soda is \$3; and Dippin' Dots is \$5. Preteens (Age 10–12) must have adult supervision. Teen parents may attend. Cost: \$3 cash at the door.

#### Fritz's Adventure

Climbing, ziplines, rope courses, warp walls, jumbo outdoor games, and more. No shorts—joggers, sweatpants and jeans are acceptable. All participants must fill out a waiver. See the app for a link to the waiver. Preteens (Age 10–12) must have adult supervision. Teen parents may attend. All adults who enter the building are required to fill out a waiver and must pay at the door. Cost: \$15 cash at the door (\$54.95 value). Unlimited fountain drinks included.

#### Track 5

Three go-cart tracks, laser tag, laser maze, arcade with 53 games, bumper boats, and mini-golf. *No shorts*—joggers, sweatpants, and jeans are acceptable. Preteens (Age 10–12) must have adult supervision. Teen parents may attend. Cost: \$17 paid at the event counter (\$49.99 value).

### **Fun and Games**

Games and fun at the convention center. Preteens (Age 10–12) must have adult supervision. Teen parents may attend. Cost: free.

Is direct mail a thing of the past? Research says "No." House to House, Heart to Heart remains the best contact generator in the churches of Christ for reaching communities with the gospel.

- Direct mail case studies show 70% of people were driven toward an online activity by direct mail.


